



The approach to the numinous is the real therapy, and in as much as you attain to the numinous experience you are released from the curse of pathology.



Numinous (/'njuminəs/) is a term derived from the Latin numen, meaning

"arousing spiritual or religious emotion; mysterious or awe-inspiring.

numen, numinis

Definitions:

- 1. divine will, divinity
- 2. god

What is the mystical?

mysticus, mystica, mysticum

Definitions:

- mystical
- of/belonging to/used in sacred mysteries/rites
- secret, mysterious

The Mystical Experience Predicts Outcomes with Psychedelics

Mystical-type experiences are the strongest mediator of therapeutic efficacy across numerous psychedelic studies in addiction, mental health, and positive outcomes.

Psilocybin can occasion mystical-type experiences having substantial and sustained personal meaning and spiritual significance

Mystical-type experiences occasioned by ketamine mediate its impact on at-risk drinking: Results from a randomized, controlled trial




FIGURE 2 | ASC (11 dimensions) of responders and non-responders at 5 weeks. Error Bars = Standard Error.



Spiritual exploration is the top reason people consume 5-MeO-DMT, study finds

Spiritual exploration (68%) was primary reason for using the drug, followed by recreation (18%) and psychological healing (12%).


Q: How can these experiences help humanity?"

Summary


- 1. Spaces inspired by and in harmony with nature.

HU Institute Symbolism


"HU" is the sound heard by an initiate when wisdom is discovered.

The 'U' in the mark represents a vessel, opening up to elevate oneself and receive the transference of wisdom from above.
















Conclusion

"Your ego is a set of thoughts that define your universe.

How might we apply the mystical to a client experience?

Each Team will design for one context.

Locations are as follows:

- 1. Traditional healthcare clinic providing 5-MeO-DMT therapy
- 2. Community care center providing ketamine-assisted group counseling to low-income residents
- 3. International Retreat Center providing Iboga to executive leaders

Design Exercise

How might we apply the mystical to a client experience?

- 1. [3-5 minutes] Patient Journey Map:
 - 1. Choose one person to be the 'patient.' This patient shall tell the story of their experience finding, entering, and moving through their context.
 - 2. As the patient tells their story, teammates shall draw a quick map of a patient journey including all of the highs and lows of the experience touch points. You might consider: the setting, physical space, guest experience, languaging around psychedelic experiences, etc.
- 2. [5-10 minutes] As a team, brainstorm a few specific touch points of the patient's journey in a way that brings the mystical to life in their experience.
- 3. [10-15 minutes] Prototype! And iterate based on feedback from your patient.
- 4. [4-5 minutes] Practice! Share the experience in a way that your fellow classmates can understand your design. This may be through prototyped objects, spaces, props and/or skits. Your share shall last no more than 4 minutes.
